 At least 3 credits must be earned in each area, with **no more than 6 credits from any one area**.
 Choose from the following:

<u>FINE ARTS</u> — any course in ART or ARH ; DAN (except DAN 101-104); MCY ; or THA

<u>LITERATURE</u> — any literature courses in ENG (200-level or higher) or literature courses in FRE , GER , ITA , POR , or SPA (300-level or higher)

MATHEMATICS and PROGRAMMING or STATISTICS (11-13 credits)

To complete the mathematics and programming/statistics requirement, student must take:

1. Two semesters of Calculus (MTH 111 and 112 or MTH 131* and 132*)
2. Either: (a) a CSC course, or (b) a statistics course (this course must be approved by the department of the student's major)

NATURAL SCIENCES (4-8 credits)

Credits must be earned in courses that count towards a major in the department offering the course.

(Courses that fulfill this requirement must be selected from one of the following departments: BIL, CHM, GSC, and PHY, and must be taken from a department other than that of the student's major and minor.)
