***Dr. Manuel Gomez*** is an Associate Professor at Florida International University's College of Law who has previously lectured at Stanford University and the Universidad Central de Venezuela Law School. He received his J.D. from the Universidad Católica Andrés Bello, Caracas, Venezuela.

He is interested in diverse topics ranging from dispute resolution and arbitration to Latin American legal policy. His latest book, *Law in Many Societies* (Stanford U. Press 2011), has received a number of accolades in the academic community. Dr. Gomez has also been appointed as an international arbitrator under the rules of the ICC, and is a founding member of the Miami International Arbitration Society.

This event will discuss the mechanisms available to ensure state compliance with decisions from the Inter-American Commission and the Court on human rights issues.
