At a time when some Latin American voices are heralding the fall of the “Wall St. Wall” and demanding a redistribution of global power, China has affirmed its presence in Latin America through trade and investment, highly visible political contacts, military exchanges, and educational, industrial and technological collaboration. Ariel Armony, Katz Distinguished Teaching Professor at Colby College and formerly a Fulbright Scholar at Nankai University, will discuss the appeal of China as an alternative model of development for Latin America as well as its role as counterweight to the United States as an increasingly relevant partner.
