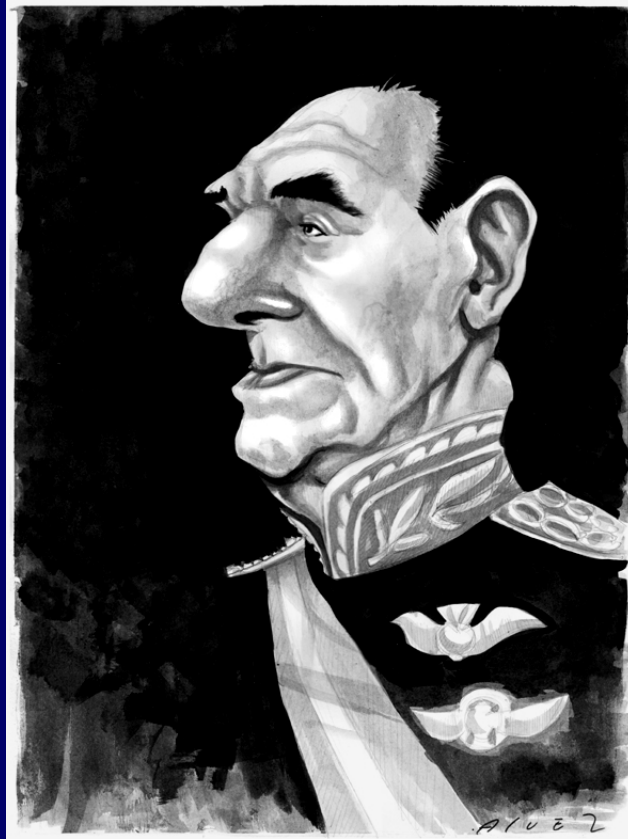

Claudia Kedar, visiting scholar from the University of Michigan's Latin American and Caribbean Studies Center and postdoctoral fellow at the Hebrew University of Jerusalem's Leonard Davis Institute for International Relations will give a lecture on Argentina during Juan Perón's rule.

Dr. Kedar reveals that the tendency to describe populist Perón as the arch-enemy of the IMF and the World Bank as instruments of the US imperialism is no more than a myth promoted by Peronists and anti-Peronists alike.
