Dr. Nelleke Van Deusen-Scholl

Director, Center for Language Study
Yale University

Dr. Van Deusen-Scholl will speak on the implications of language/culture education in the context of the global mission of a university. Her workshop will focus on a variety of issues central to the teaching and learning of foreign languages and cultures in a global context, such as the connection between classroom learning and study abroad experiences, discipline-specific and interdisciplinary models of language learning, advanced learning, and non-traditional approaches to language education. The workshop will provide opportunities for discussion and reflection and encourages active participation from the audience.

Dr. Van Deusen Scholl has worked with academic institutions to examine the study of language/culture education in the context of a global mission. Prior to assuming directorship of the Center For Language Study at Yale University, Dr. Van Deusen-Scholl was Director of the University of Pennsylvania Language Center in the School of Arts and Sciences and adjunct Associate professor in the Graduate School of Education.
