

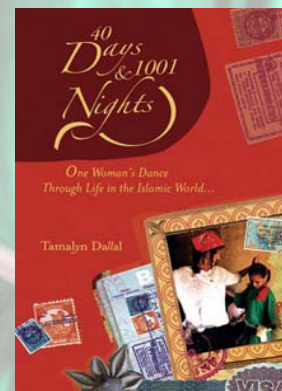
"From Bogotá to Zanzibar: A Woman's Dance Across Borders and Ideology"
