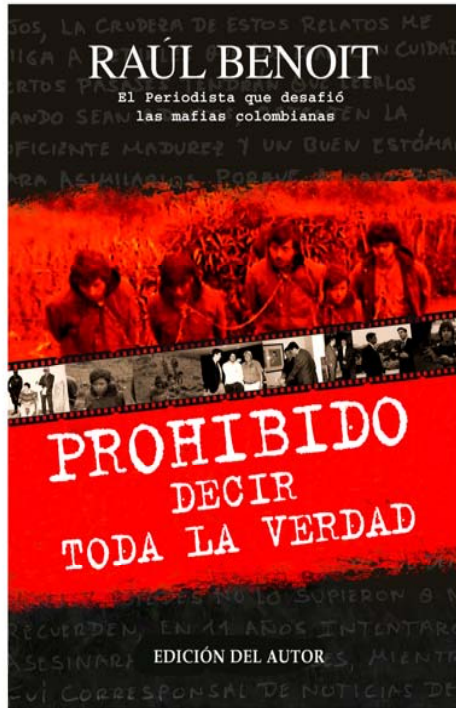

## “Prohibido decir toda la verdad”

Raul Benoit is a broadcast journalist from Univision Network, as well as a writer and columnist of several Spanish-speaking newspapers in the United States and Latin America. He has worked with Univision for the past 22 years, the last eight of these as a correspondent of the weekly investigative show “Aquí y Ahora.” He is considered one of the most influent Hispanic journalists in the US.

Raúl Benoit will be commenting on his book “Prohibido decir toda la verdad”, which describes his experiences covering drug trafficking in Colombia during the 80s and 90s. Benoit unveils the mask of both the paramilitaries and the communist guerrillas. He tells his encounters with drug dealers, guerrilla warriors, former presidents and government officials, and reveals details never told before.
