João Antônio Telles completed a Ph.D. in Educational Linguistics at OISE - Ontario Institute for Studies in Education, University of Toronto in 1996 and his postdoctoral studies at the Université Charles de Gaulle, Lille III, France in 2003. He is currently Associate Professor in the Department of Education, Faculty of Science and Arts of the Universidade Estadual Paulista, Julio de Mesquita Filho, Campus de Assis-SP, where he teaches English Language Teaching. He works in the UNESP Rio Preto Program in Graduate Studies (Linguistic Studies - Applied Linguistics) by directing dissertations and theses in the areas of teacher training and language learning for native and foreign languages. He has published 15 articles in professional journals in Brazil and abroad and 37 works in annals of events. He is the leader of the Research Group ‘Teletandem Brazil: Foreign Languages for all’ (www.teletandembrasil.org). João Telles has written 9 book chapters, 2 book organizations and 1 published book. He is a member of the Editorial Board of journals such as the Brazilian Journal of Applied Linguistics, Papers in Applied Linguistics (UNICAMP), Language & Education (UCPEL), Theory and Practice of Education (EMU) and the UL - International Journal of Qualitative Studies in Education (University of Texas at Austin). He has supervised 9 dissertations, 5 doctoral theses and 9 basic scientific works in the areas of Education, Linguistics and Literature and Education. Currently, João Telles coordinates the FAPESP sponsored Teletandem Brazil: Foreign Languages for all.
