Professeur Bertaud received her Ph.D. from the University of Paris IV – Sorbonne. She taught French literature at the University of Strasbourg before joining the University of Nancy, and has been a member of the Committee of Experts of the University of Paris IV - Sorbonne Department of Letters. She is the President of the Association pour la Diffusion de la Recherche Littéraire and the Chief-Editor of the prestigious scholarly journal *Travaux de Littérature* since 1988. She has authored 4 books, has edited a dozen volumes, and published over 70 articles on French 17th century literature. Most recently, she started to work on contemporary French writers, including Cheng (on whom she is currently completing a book), Makine and Rachid O.
