Louis M. Guenin is Lecturer on Ethics in Science in the Department of Microbiology and Molecular Genetics, Harvard Medical School. His research lies mainly in distributive justice, the ethics of research, and the philosophy of science. He has served as a consultant to the federal government on research ethics, and as cochair of the Ethics Committee, International Society for Stem Cell Research. He edited and contributed to a recent issue of *Synthese* on candor in science, and is the author of *The Morality of Embryo Use* (Cambridge University Press, in press).
