BIOGRAPHICAL ABSTRACTS

Noah Lemos is Professor and Chair of the Philosophy Department at the College of William and Mary. He has taught at Virginia Tech, Texas, and DePauw University and specializes in epistemology and ethics. He is the author of *Intrinsic Value* (Cambridge 1994), *Common Sense* (Cambridge 2004), and *An Introduction to the Theory of Knowledge* (Cambridge, forthcoming). He is also the author of "Ethics and Epistemology" in *The Oxford Handbook of Epistemology* (Oxford 2002) and "Moore and Skepticism" in *The Oxford Handbook of Skepticism* (Oxford, forthcoming).

John Lemos is Associate Professor of Philosophy and Chairman of the Department of Philosophy and Religion at Coe College in Cedar Rapids, IA. He received his Ph.D. from Duke University in the spring of 1993 and began teaching at Coe College in the fall of the same year. He is the author of numerous articles on a broad range of topics in philosophy. His articles have appeared in *The Southern Journal of Philosophy*, *The American Catholic Philosophical Quarterly*, *Philosophy of the Social Sciences*, *Philosophia*, *Metaphilosophy*, and in other publications. He also has a book, *Common Sense Darwinism*, forthcoming in the fall of 2007. It is an exploration of some of the possible philosophical implications of evolutionary biology.
