Michael Ruse is Lucyle T. Werkmeister Professor of Philosophy at Florida State University. He received his Ph.D. in Philosophy from the University of Bristol (1970). The author of many books, including *The Philosophy of Biology* and *Taking Darwin Seriously*, he is also the founder and editor of the journal *Biology and Philosophy*. He has appeared on "Quirks and Quarks" and the Discovery Channel. He has worked in the philosophy of biology (especially Darwinism), ethics, and history and philosophy of science. In his latest book he uncovers surprising similarities between evolutionist and creationist thinking.
