Leonard Carrier (Ph.D., Stanford) is Emeritus Professor of Philosophy, University of Miami. He taught at Macquarie University (Sydney, Australia) and the University of South Florida (Tampa) before teaching at the University of Miami from 1971 to 2000. His chief philosophical interests are in epistemology and philosophy of mind.

Howard Pospesel (Ph.D., University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill) is Emeritus Professor of Philosophy, University of Miami. He is the author of four logic textbooks: *Propositional Logic*, *Predicate Logic*, (with Robert E. Rodes, Jr.) *Premises and Conclusions*, and (with David Marans) *Arguments*, all published by Prentice-Hall, and collaborated with Dr. James Shelley on the creation of *SANDY*, a logic tutorial computer program. He has published articles in logic, epistemology and ontology and received the James W. McLamore Outstanding Service Award in 1989.
