Scott Sturgeon is Reader in Philosophy at Birkbeck College, London. He is primarily interested in epistemology, meta-ethics, metaphysics and the philosophy of mind. He is currently working on a number of things, one of which is a book on epistemic norms--usefully called *Epistemic Norms*--to be published by Oxford University Press. In 2002 he was Visiting Associate Professor at Harvard; and in 2005 he was Weinberg Distinguished Visiting Professor at the University of Michigan, Ann Arbor.
