

Internship and Research on European affairs, conducted in Barcelona, Spain

Available Summer 2018



The University of Miami **European Union “Jean Monnet” Chair** is offering an innovative program combining an **internship** training and **individualized research** supervision. Available to all **undergraduate and graduate** students at the University of Miami, it is part of the operations of a grant awarded by the European Union. A **certificate of expertise** will be issued for successful trainees. This experience is highly valued when applying for internships at the EU sites or other private and government employment.

To receive full **academic credit** for UM requirements, candidates **must register** in one of the European Union courses **INS 590 or alternatives**. In addition to following the course, trainees will be placed (depending of inclinations and background) in a selective government of private agency or business in Barcelona for a few hours of practical training.

It is expected that the background of the trainee will match the needs and expectations of the governments (the City of Barcelona, the government of Catalonia and the branches of the Spanish government) and/or the private businesses (international trade and transportation, tourism, and media, among others). In any case, students will experience in a practical way the benefits of belonging to the European Union.

The **internship training** includes drafting a short report resulting in a mini-paper, including data-collecting, documents development, social media, briefings and lecture reporting, as they are usually required in EU-related internships.
