

**"New Frontiers in French
Theater History"**

How do we conduct research on past theatrical performances? What are the possibilities and pitfalls of trying to "capture" and explain ephemeral moments of human interaction? How do theater and performance help create alternative ways of remembering? In this presentation, Logan Connors discusses several methods for studying theatrical events of the past, particularly in the French-speaking world. The talk will center theater history as means of analyzing broad sociopolitical issues such as patriotism, revolution, colonialism, inclusion, and militarized nationalism.
