

CAS Open Access Publication Support Funding for FY27

For the 2027 fiscal year the College of Arts & Sciences, in its efforts to support faculty scholarship and enhance its dissemination, offers the following support for publications in high-impact, open access journals:

Up to \$4,000 per article for open access publications in journals within the top quartile of their discipline *and* with impact factors ≥ 8 . Total open access funding for the FY will be limited and approved on a first-come, first-served basis.

This support is limited to publications having Arts & Sciences faculty as lead or corresponding author for which invoices are paid during the period June 1, 2026—May 31, 2027. Individual faculty may receive funds for only one article during this period.

To be considered for funding, faculty should submit documentation (publisher's invoice including title of work and authors) to Sr. Assoc. Dean Joshua Cohn (jcohn@miami.edu). Invoices should be processed by departments and reimbursement requested from CAS for eligible publication costs up to the amount approved.

Faculty are reminded that the UM Libraries currently fund article processing charges for affiliated authors publishing in PLOS, Institute of Physics, Wiley, and Frontiers journals, and have agreements with several other journals that reduce or waive processing charges (<https://guides.library.miami.edu/open-access>). The Office of the Vice Provost for Research also supports a limited number of high-impact publications through its *Publications Award for U* program.
